Its name derives from Hardwick Hall, a residence of the 7th Duke of Devonshire, whose Agent and our 1st Worshipful Master, W.W. Jeudwine was based. Lodge members take a great deal of pride in the high standard of ritual displayed in the ceremonies, with its musical content, which greatly enhances the atmosphere of the occasion.
